Game: Oh No! Skill: Initial /l/ Players: 2-4 Object: to have the most cards at the end of the game How to play:

- 1. Review cards with the students (optional)
- 2.Mix up the cards and spread them randomly in front of all players, picture side down.
- 3. The first player picks a card and says the target word (3x, in a sentence, etc)
- 4. First player continues to draw and say target words until an "OH NO!" card is drawn, at which point the second player can begin his/her turn. (NOTE: if "OH NO!" is the first card drawn, play immediately moves to the next player.
- 5.Continue until all cards are gone.
- 6.Count cards, including "OH NO!" cards to determine the winner.

This game, as far as I know, was invented by my friend Lisa Gastelle, creative genius.
